Paul C.J. LeBlanc Memorial Bursary Guidelines

Ability NB is pleased to offer the Paul C.J. LeBlanc Memorial Bursary. \$1,000 bursaries will be given to two youth who live with a mobility disability who are enrolled in higher education in New Brunswick.

The bursaries are in memory of Paul C.J. LeBlanc. Paul was a strong advocate for equity in education and employment for persons with a mobility disability. He worked as a Senior Communications Officer at Atlantic Canada Opportunities Agency for the past 20 years.



The Bursary's goal is to help youths in financial need throughout their post-secondary education.

TO APPLY:

Complete the Paul C.J. Memorial Bursary General Application – Part 1 and Write a one-page essay. The essay must include the following details:

- Describe your disability (1-2 sentences).
- Describe the obstacles faced in school/jobs due to your mobility disability and the steps you have taken to overcome them.
- Describe your determination to be successful in your studies.
- Tell us what your career goals are and how you plan to reach them.
- Briefly describe the financial roadblocks you face in your pathway to education. Explain how this bursary would help you overcome these obstacles.

SELECTION PROCESS:

Once your General Application has been sent (including the one-page essay), an Ability NB staff will review it to ensure it meets the application guidelines. Only applications that meet all guidelines will be sent to the Ability NB Board of Directors Selection Committee. This selection committee will determine the 2 bursary recipients based on the applications.

Recipients will be contacted in February 2023.
